Caregiver Support— oneon-one support services with Caregivers feeling overwhelmed in their caregiving role with the goal of reducing stress and strengthening their natural support system.

#### Care Coordination-

professionally certified Care Coordinators provide free, in-home assessments to identify and set up supports for individuals living independently in the community.

LTC Ombudsman— meet with nursing home residents to help resolve concerns or complaints. They provide a listening ear to residents and families.

#### Adult Protective Services-

investigate and resolve reported cases of self neglect, abuse, neglect, or financial exploitation for older adults, (over age 60) and adults with disabilities (age 18-59).

Money Management Program— assist individuals with bill paying, writing checks, budgeting and balancing their checkbook.

My name is David Beebe and I am a Caregiver Counselor with Alternatives and a Caregiver. Being a Caregiver sandwiched between managing my immediate family and caring for my aging mother, I know its no easy job. Your situation may involve the difficult transition of roles and the feeling of parenting your parent or spouse. Perhaps you feel lost when parenting grandchildren in a new generation. On top of the "normal" stress of providing day-to-day care, could be additional family and relationship dynamics that make giving care more difficult. When overwhelmed by the strain of caregiving, it can feel lonely. I'm here to say you are not alone. If you are a Caregiver who is overwhelmed, need a safe space to share your concerns, or explore resources and support, please reach out. There are others who have felt similar emotions to what you are feeling. Whether you are caring for your parents, spouse, or are an older adult raising children, being a caregiver is not an easy role. You don't have to go it alone.
